



ART OF SHOCK

The real story is survival. Art Of Shock is entering a new era.

"You Are The Plague" is the first statement from their new partnership with AOMFS Records. The song moves without warning between speed and crushing heaviness, shifting from powerful clean vocals to vicious growls without ever losing sight of the hook. It is direct, unpredictable, and uncompromised.

But this new era did not arrive clean. It was dragged out of years of pressure, setbacks, relentless chaos, and a refusal to disappear.

Forged in Los Angeles, Art Of Shock now brings together Art Geezar, Adrian Geezar, and Brice Snyder. They cut their teeth on the Sunset Strip, at one point becoming the Whisky a Go Go's unofficial house band and turning its legendary stage into their proving ground.

That energy followed Art Of Shock onto the Vans Warped Tour, where they commanded the stage by day and put their notorious party credentials to work hosting the tour's afterparties every night.

Two full-length releases through Century Media Records followed, landing Art Of Shock on Billboard, VEVO, and college radio charts. The band toured and shared stages with artists including Sepultura, Crowbar, Brujeria, Sacred Reich, Trivium, Hiram, and Cavalera Conspiracy, building a reputation on explosive performances, crushing anthems, ferocious vocals, and massive hooks.

All of it happened under constant pressure.

Lineup changes, personal losses, financial strain, industry upheaval, broken plans, and the disruption of the pandemic repeatedly forced Art Of Shock to rebuild. None of it became a victim story. Every setback created new material. Every collapse demanded another version of the band. Survival was never about protecting the past, it was about turning whatever remained into something louder.

That instinct drives "You Are The Plague."

The song confronts weaponized misinformation, anti-scientific thinking, and political control disguised as religious faith. It targets those who turn ignorance into influence and use that influence to drag society backward.

The aggression is not abstract. It has a target. For Art Of Shock, this is not a comeback or a reset. It is the next move from a band that has survived enough to know exactly what matters and has no intention of slowing down.
